EMPLOYER BARGAINING AGENCY DESIGNATION

By a Designation dated March 21, 1978, the Labour Bureau and the Ontario General Contractors Association ("Bureau") was designated as part of the "rodworker" employer bargaining agency to represent in bargaining all employers whose employees are represented by certain affiliated bargaining agents.

Since then, the Bureau has incorporated and changed its name to the "Construction Labour Relations Association of Ontario", so it has become necessary to replace the Designation.

THEREFORE, pursuant to my authority under subsection 153(5) of the *Labour Relations Act, 1995*, I hereby revoke the above-mentioned Designation and substitute the following Designation:

Pursuant to clause 153(1)(b) of the *Labour Relations Act, 1995*, I hereby designate an Association consisting of,

- (a) the Construction Labour Relations Association of Ontario;
- (b) the Reinforced Steel Institute; and
- (c) the Industrial Contractors Association of Canada,

as the employer bargaining agency to represent in bargaining in the industrial, commercial and institutional ("ICI") sector of the construction industry in Ontario all employers whose rodworker employees are represented by,

- (d) the International Association of Bridge, Structural and Ornamental Iron Workers, and the Iron Workers District Council of Ontario; or
- (e) Local Unions 700, 721, 736, 759, 765, 786; or
- (f) any other Local of the International Association of Bridge, Structural and Ornamental Iron Workers which in the future may be chartered to represent rodworkers,

(hereinafter collectively referred to as the "Unions") and all employers bound by or parties to,

- (g) a certificate of the Ontario Labour Relations Board granted to the Unions or any of them;
- (h) a voluntary recognition agreement with the Unions or any of them; or
- (i) a collective agreement to which the Unions or any of them have been or are party to or bound by,

covering the ICI sector of the construction industry in Ontario.
