EMPLOYEE BARGAINING AGENCY DESIGNATION

By a previous Designation dated March 21, 1978 (amended by Designations dated April 12, 1978 and April 28, 1986), the Sheet Metal Workers' International Association and the Ontario Sheet Metal Workers' Conference were designated as part of the "sheet metal" employee bargaining agency to represent in bargaining all journeymen and apprentice sheet metal workers, sheeters, sheeters' assistants and material handlers represented by certain affiliated bargaining agents.

Since then, Local 392 of the Sheet Metal Workers' International Association has ceased to exist so it has become necessary to replace the Designation.

THEREFORE, pursuant to my authority under subsection 153(5) of the *Labour Relations Act, 1995*, I hereby revoke the above-mentioned Designations, dated March 21, 1978, April 12, 1978 and April 28, 1986, and substitute the following Designation:

Pursuant to clause 153(1)(a) of the *Labour Relations Act, 1995*, I hereby designate the Sheet Metal Workers' International Association and the Ontario Sheet Metal Workers' Conference consisting of Locals 30, 47, 235, 269, 397, 473, 504, 537, 539 and 562 of the Sheet Metal Workers' International Association as the employee bargaining agency to represent in bargaining in the industrial, commercial and institutional ("ICI") sector of the construction industry of Ontario all journeymen and apprentice sheet metal workers, sheeters, sheeters' assistants and material handlers represented by,

- (a) the Sheet Metal Workers' International Association and the Ontario Sheet Metal Workers' Conference, or
- (b) Local Unions 30, 47, 235, 269, 397, 473, 504, 537, 539 and 562, or
- (c) any other Local of the Sheet Metal Workers' International Association which in the future may be chartered to represent journeymen and apprentice sheet metal workers, sheeters, sheeters' assistants and material handlers,

(hereinafter collectively referred to as the "Unions") and to represent in bargaining as above-described all employees bound by or parties to,

- (a) a certificate of the Ontario Labour Relations Board granted to the Unions or any of them,
- (b) a voluntary recognition agreement with the Unions or any of them, or

(c) a collective agreement to which the Unions or any of them have been or are party to or bound by,

covering the ICI sector of the construction industry in Ontario.
