EMPLOYEE BARGAINING AGENCY DESIGNATION

Pursuant to clause a of subsection 1 of section 127 of The Labour Relations Act, R.S.O. 1970, c. 232, as amended, I hereby designate the International Brotherhood of Boilermakers, Iron Shipbuilders, Blacksmiths, Forgers and Helpers as the employee bargaining agency to represent in bargaining in the industrial, commercial and institutional sector of the construction industry all Journeymen and Apprentice Boilermakers, represented by the International Brotherhood of Boilermakers, Iron Shipbuilders, Blacksmiths, Forgers and Helpers or Lodge 128 of the International Brotherhood of Boilermakers, Iron Shipbuilders, Blacksmiths, Forgers and Helpers or any other lodge of the International Brotherhood of Boilermakers, Iron Shipbuilders, Blacksmiths, Forgers and Helpers that might be chartered to represent Boilermakers in the industrial, commercial and institutional sector of the construction industry.

Pursuant to subsection 2 of section 127 of The Labour Relations Act, I hereby exclude from this designation the bargaining relationships between the Quality Control Council of Canada and the Stress Relieving Contractors and between the Quality Control Council of Canada and the NDT Management Association. This exclusion is subject to the condition that the constitution of the Quality-Control Council of Canada is filed together with a copy of the collective agreements affecting these employees.
